**III. Storing your data**

**1. Scope and purpose of the processing of personal data**

We store the following data for the organization of an event on a socio-politically relevant topic and in the context of subsequent events:

Institution/organisation, department, position, salutation, title (academic), letter salutation, first name, last name, street, postal code, town/city, country, telephone number, e-mail address, mobile number, photos and videos. We process photos, videos, first names and last names for the following purposes: for publication on the Internet

The photos and video recordings may also provide information about your ethnic origin, religion or health (e.g. skin colour, headgear, glasses). If you do not agree to the processing of photos, videos, first names and last names, you should not use the video chat, for example, in the context of digital question and answer sessions (Q&A sessions).

This data is stored electronically on a server in accordance with the GDPR. The data is initially stored on the server of a service provider, then on the servers of the State Parliament. IT companies and service providers advising us on security may also have access to the data if this is absolutely necessary. The respective companies are obligated by us to comply with data protection regulations.

**2. Legal basis for processing personal data**

The legal basis for processing is your consent under Art. 6 para. 1 lit. e) GDPR.

**3. Deletion and storage of data**

The data will be deleted when the purpose of storage no longer applies. This is the case when the activity on the basis of which we saved your data ends.

**IV. Your rights**

If your personal data is processed, you are a data subject within the meaning of the GDPR and you have the following rights with respect to us as the data controller:

**1. Right to information**

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored on your person. (Art. 15 GDPR)

**2. Right to rectification**

You have a right to correct and/or add to the personal data held by the data controller if it is incorrect or incomplete. We are required to make the correction immediately. (Art. 16 GDPR)

**3. Right to erasure or restriction of processing**

If the legal requirements are met, you can request the deletion or restriction of processing. (Art. 17, 18 GDPR)

**4. Right to object**

If the legal requirements are met, you can object to the processing. (Art. 21 GDPR)

**5. Right to data portability**

If you have consented to data processing or a contract for data processing exists and data processing is carried out using automated procedures, you may have the right to data transferability. (Art. 20 GDPR)

**6. The right to file a legal complaint with a supervisory authority**

In case of complaints regarding data protection and applicable regulations, you can contact the competent supervisory authority.
