### **3. Legal basis of the processing**

Your data will be processed on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR in conjunction with Section 3 LDSG (State Data Protection Act).

### **4. Expected duration of time for which the personal data will be held**

The saved recordings are usually deleted immediately after the event, but no later than 3 months after the recording unless they are required to document the event or are archived.

### **5. Rights of the data subject**

According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored on your person (Art. 15 GDPR).

Should incorrect personal data be processed, you have a right to correction (Art. 16 GDPR).

If the legal requirements are met, you may request the deletion or restriction of the processing and file an objection against the processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).

If you have consented to data processing or a contract for data processing exists and data processing is carried out using automated procedures, you may have a right to data transferability (Art. 20 GDPR).

Should you make use of your above-mentioned rights, the State Parliament will check whether the legal requirements for this have been fulfilled.
